



## 2022 BATTLE OF THE BANDS ARTIST APPLICATION FORM AND ENTRY GUIDELINES

*Please complete this application form and the stage plan (last page) and return to the FReeZA Committee.*

1. Entry is free of charge - but participants must cover all costs incurred by travel and accommodation.
2. All prospective participants must meet and be aware of all of these condition:
  - Acts must contain members who live, work, recreate or study in Central Victoria. Only acts whose members fall into these categories will be given a performance opportunity (at the FReeZA workers discretion).
  - No members can exceed 25 years of age or be younger than 12 years of age at the date application is submitted.
  - Performers are not to have a recording, publishing or distribution deal.
  - FReeZA Battle of the Bands is open to soloists, duos, bands, and artists of all styles and genres. The competition is of most benefit to artists performing original material.
  - FReeZA Battle of the Bands is not a “talent competition” and therefore not the right platform for DJs and dancers.
3. Submission of an application inclusive of a CD, MP3s, photo or bio does not guarantee participation in the program. All applicants will be notified on whether they were successful by email within 14 days of the participant submitting their application.
4. Bands who have entered, and placed first, in any other Battle of the Bands event are not permitted to enter the Mount Alexander Shire Battle of the Bands as the same band (½ of the band must be new members).
5. All acts must adhere strictly to their performance time, or have points deducted for playing over-time.
6. No more than ½ of any bands’ members can play in any other band performing at the event. (Solo & duo artists are exempt.)

7. All acts must have at least one member in attendance at the artist meeting. The date and venue will be advised by the local FReeZA committee 2 weeks advance. This can be negotiated for those residing more than 50km distance from Castlemaine.
  
8. At each FReeZA event, there is backline equipment provided for your use. This includes full PA, drumkit, guitar and bass amplifiers. A drum kit will be supplied, but you may use your own snare drum, kick pedal, hi-hats and cymbals. You also need to adhere to the strict stage times that will be clearly communicated to you before and at the event. All performers are responsible for their own equipment and no responsibility will be taken by the event organisers for any damaged or lost equipment. Should you wish to use your own equipment (ie: guitar/bass amplifiers or heads, drum hardware), this will be at the local FReeZA worker's discretion. Please contact them in advance to discuss. **It is important that all equipment is to be tested and tagged, and clearly labelled**; suitable verification is required for equipment collection.
  
9. No pass outs will be available to ANYONE competing at the event – excluding paid performers over 18 years (as per FReeZA guidelines)
  
10. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into on the night. Participants can request the judge's feedback and comments form after the event.
  
11. FReeZA Battle of the Bands is a Victorian Government-funded program promoting safe all-ages events. A high standard of behaviour is expected from all artists and personnel who are involved. This includes:
  - Respecting that all FReeZA events are entirely drug, alcohol and smoke-free.
  - No coarse language or content which discriminates on the basis of sex, gender, race, age, sexual preferences etc. or glorifying of drug and alcohol use during your performance will be tolerated.
  - No pass outs (leaving the venue) are permitted
  - Following all Covid safe event practices as directed by the Victorian State Government (conditions may change)
  - Working with security staff and event managers in matters of crowd control and safety.

Violation of the above behaviours could result in immediate disqualification, at the discretion of the FReeZA worker present on the night. In addition to the above behavioural clause, there may be other venue and event specific directives that the FReeZA worker will provide at the artist meeting or event.
