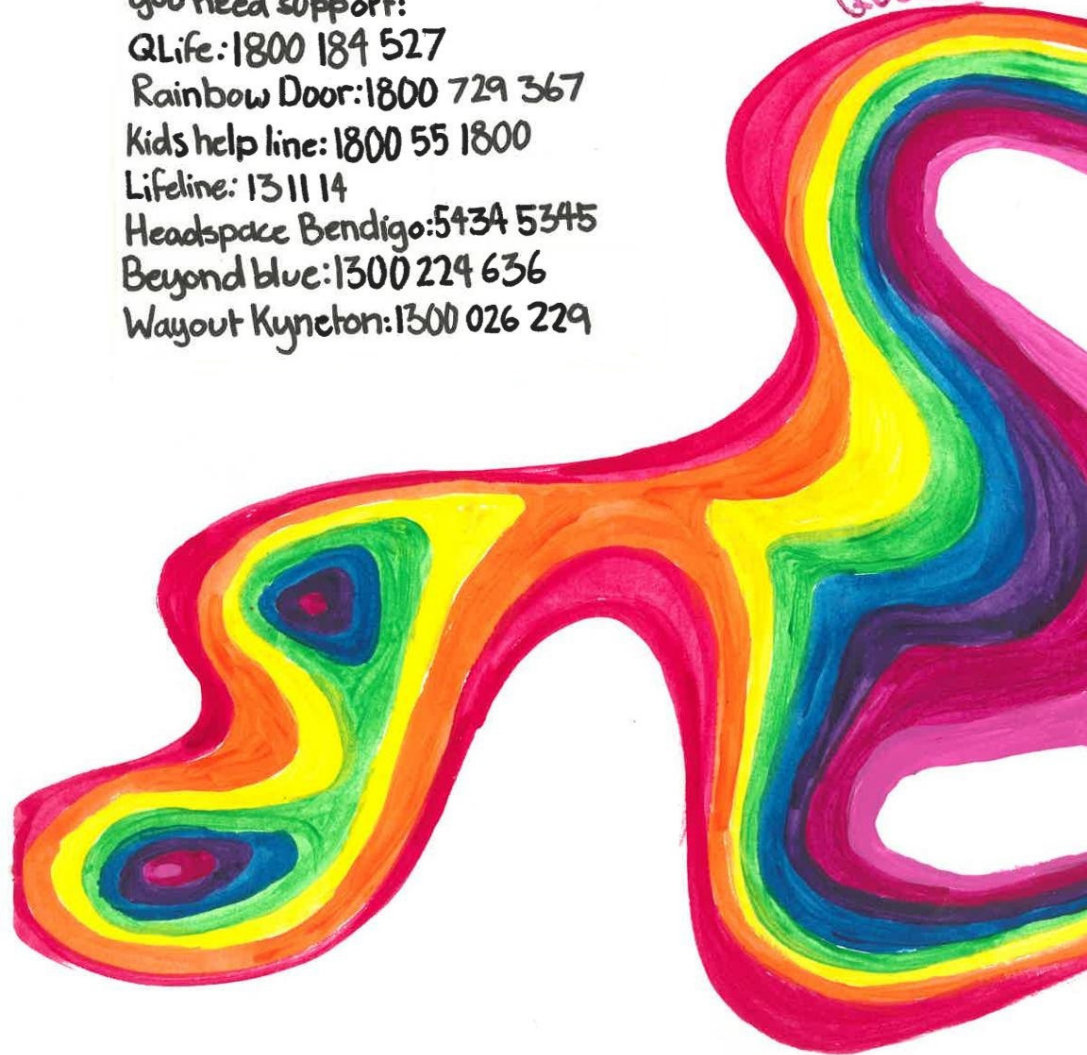

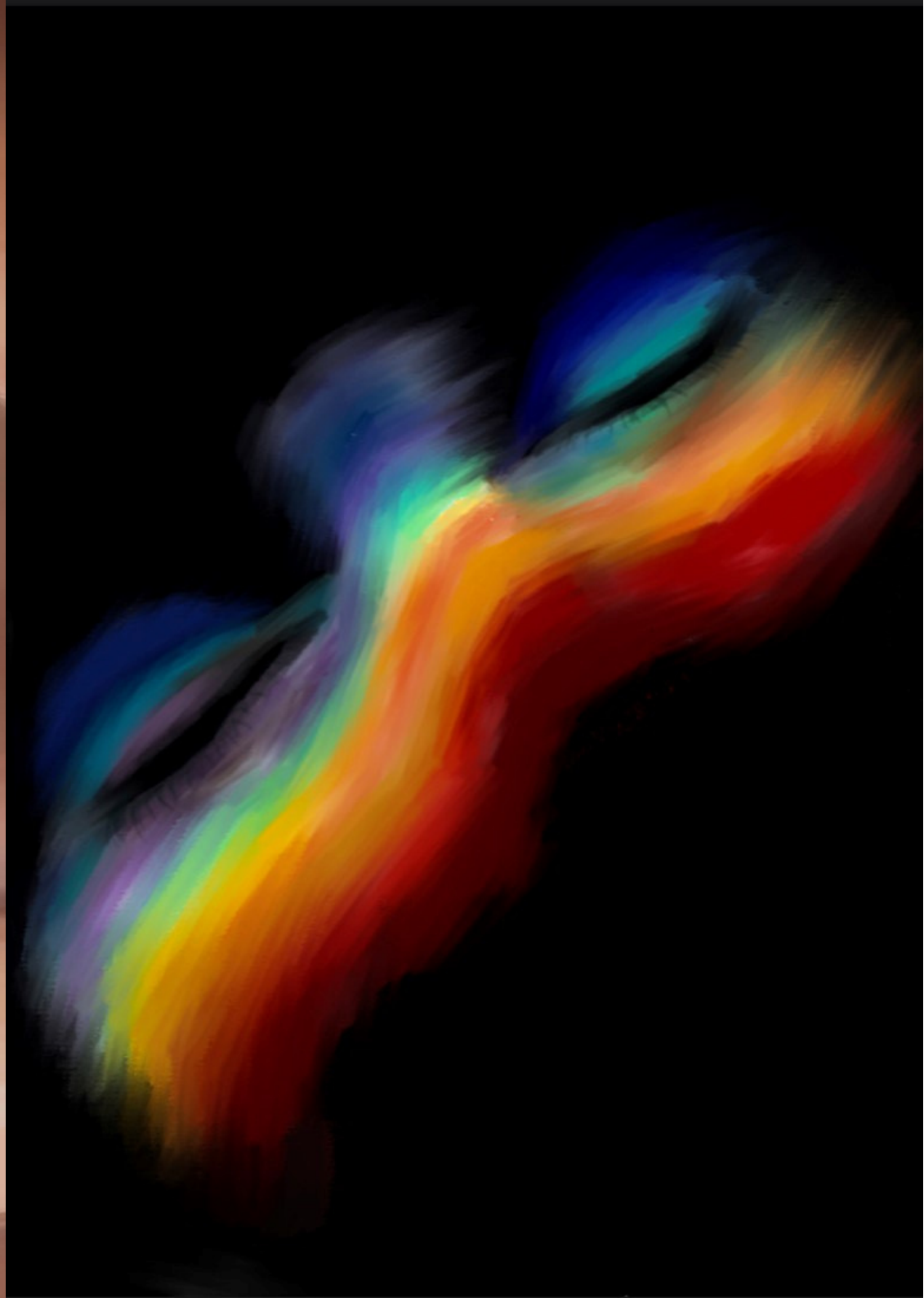

Pronouns are the words we often use to talk about a person when we're not using their name

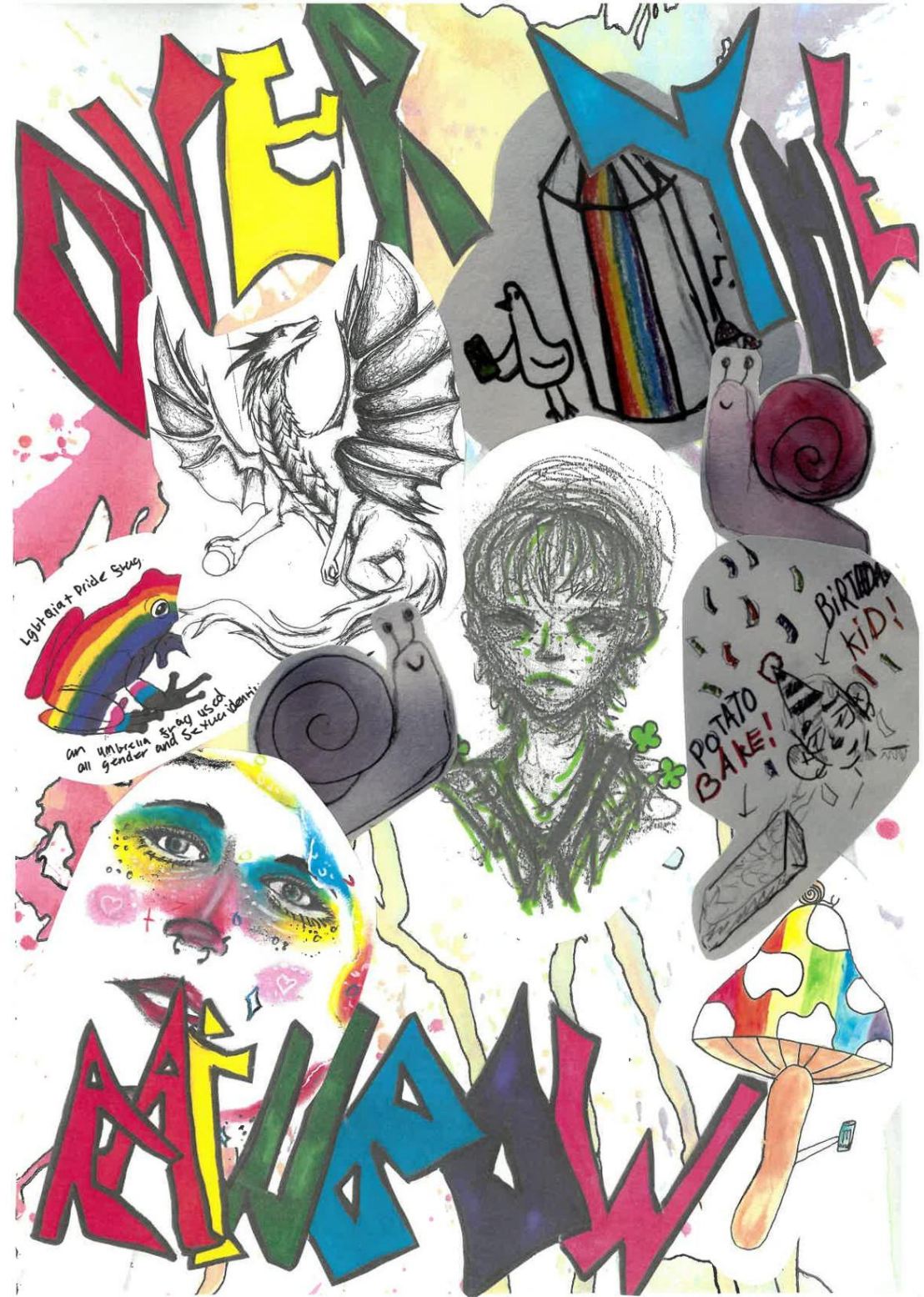
Some examples:

Bisexual Pride Stag



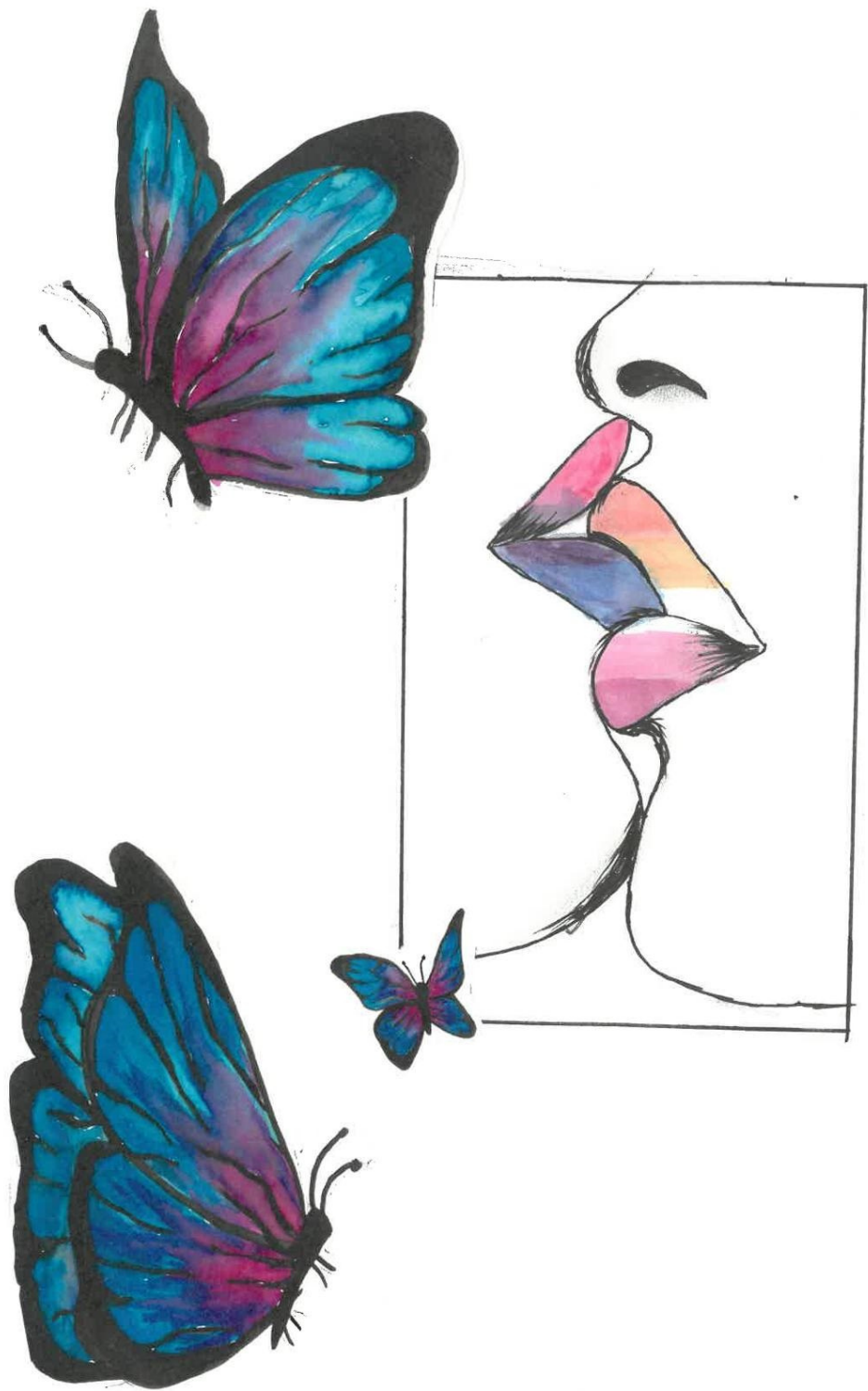
